





Catholic Funeral Plan [®] is a faithbased, pre-need plan for those age 50 and over. The plan allows Catholics to make their funeral arrangements in advance.


This plan guarantees that, at the time of your passing, the funeral arrangement's you've selected will be executed in accordance with your wishes and the liturgical traditions of the Church.


