

Winter Decoration Removal is scheduled for March 1st.



All decorations are removed and disposed of beginning MARCH 1st. Decorations will not be retained by the cemetery. If you wish to retain any of these decorations, you must remove them prior to this date. Evergreens become dried out and lose color after two months of exposure to wind, sun, and snow. Removal at this time allows clean up of the cemetery prior to the Easter Season. If weather conditions do not permit removal on MARCH 1st, they will be removed as soon as practical after this date. It can take weeks to remove all winter decorations.

Thank you for helping to keep the Cemetery looking beautiful.





What Is a Prayer Card?




Ash Wednesday is March 5th...it's the beginning of the Lenten Season
