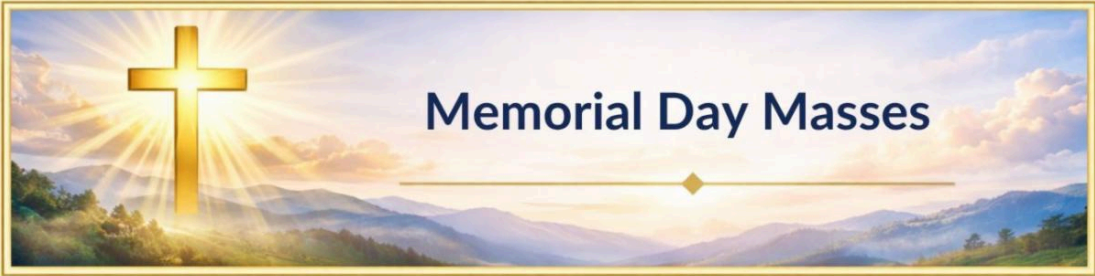

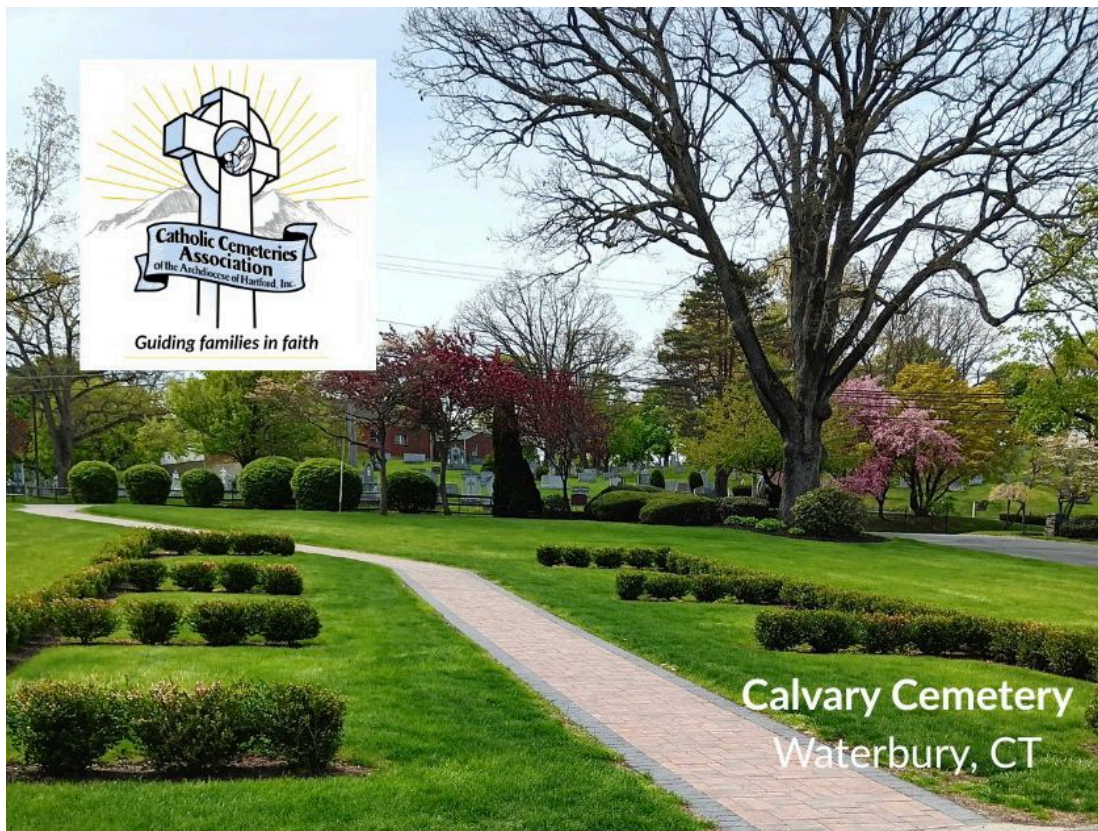

## **New Columbarium Niches**

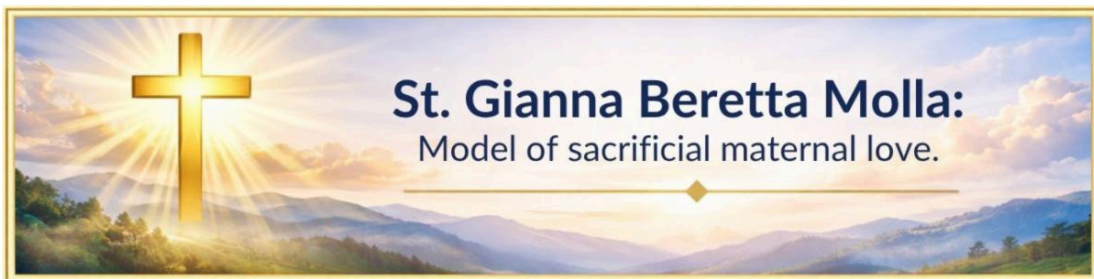
All Saints Cemetery - North Haven

This beautifully designed structure provides families with a serene space for prayer, remembrance, and visitation for generations to come.

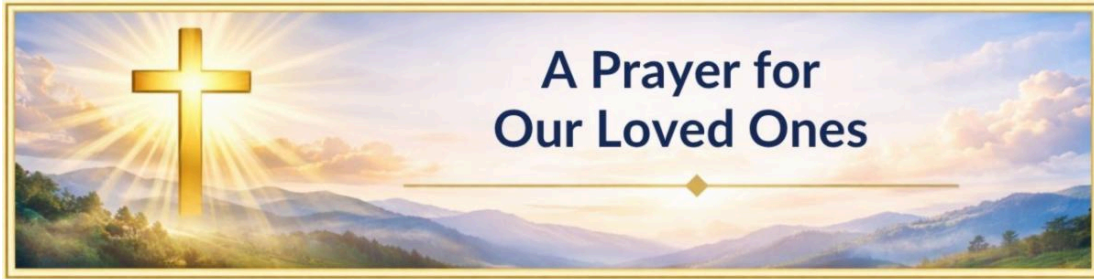


Contact All Saints Cemetery



St. Gianna Beretta Molla was a wife, mother, and pediatrician from Italy whose life reflected deep faith and selfless love. Living in the mid-20th

century, she saw her medical work as a mission to care for life. When faced with a life-threatening pregnancy, she chose to protect her unborn child, placing her trust in God above all else. She was canonized as a saint in 2004, and her legacy remains a powerful reminder of the sacrificial love that defines motherhood.

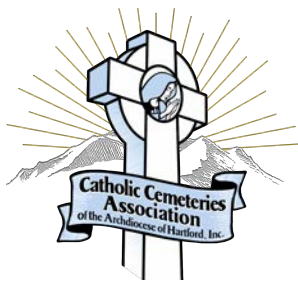
